
Programme: Thurrock OnTrack

Ashley was sent by the jobcentre on an employability course and while on it he was told about the OnTrack programme running in Thurrock. As he was keen to get into work he decided that he would enrol on the programme.



One of the major areas Ashley felt he needed to improve was his confidence. The team looked at the best way to help him achieve this. Over the course of the programme his confidence steadily improved.

His Adviser also helped him to write a successful CV, which enabled him to get job interviews. He also needed some support with his approach to interviews which he received through mentoring. "It has built my confidence and made me able to write a good CV and it gave me good interviews skills."
